Where My Water Bill Payments Go

As the cost of water continues to rise, we thought it would be helpful to show *residential only* customers what is billed and where your payment goes.

If you were to use 10,000 gallons of water, your total bill would be \$82.50. Of that total:

- \$45.50 is the fee paid to the North Harris County Regional Water Authority (NHCRWA). The fee is currently \$4.00 / 1,000 gallons, increasing in May 2019 to \$4.55 / 1,000 gallons.
- \$12.00 is the water fee charged by Harris County W.C.I.D. No. 110 (There is a flat fee of \$11.00 / 8,000 gallons used, and a variable fee per thousand gallons is charged over 8,000 gallons of use.)
- \$10.07 is the flat sewer fee charged by Harris County W.C.I.D. No. 110
- \$14.93 is the garbage collection / recycling fee paid to Best Trash (this fee is included with the sewer fee on your bill)




Chart based on 10,000 gallons of water used at residential rates. Percentages shown will vary based on actual use.
