All WCID110 residents are welcome to attend the meetings.



Wondering about the construction activity on Seals Gully? Seals Gully is part of the Cypress Creek Watershed (Z100-00-00-X285) which is in the collection of major maintenance projects that will repair various types of channel failures along 5 different project areas within the Cypress Creek Watershed. Portions of the identified channels are considered to be in serious failure and these repairs are necessary to prevent further impact to the channels.

Harris County Flood Control District is currently working to restore channel conveyance capacity to its original design. Seals Gully (project **K124-00-00-X036**) consists of the removal of concrete rubble, excavation and disposal of natural soils, re-grading of existing on-site materials, installation of backslope swales, installation of backslope interceptor structures, installation of riprap, installation and maintenance of SWPP items, beginning approximately 250 linear feet downstream and ending 1,850 linear feet downstream of Cypresswood Drive. Construction has begun and is expected to be completed Fall 2020 depending on weather.


